

## SGX-Listed InnoTek Unveils New Manufacturing Facility in Melaka, Malaysia, To Support Growth in Southeast Asia



**SINGAPORE, 16 April 2026** – SGX Mainboard-listed **InnoTek Limited** (“InnoTek” or the “Group”) today declared open a new 10,000 sqm (approximately 107,639 sqft) manufacturing facility in Melaka, Malaysia, to broaden its manufacturing presence across Southeast Asia and increase production capacity for precision metal-stamped components in the region.

The Melaka facility comprises two main buildings incorporating production, warehousing and office functions, and is operated through Mansfield Manufacturing (M) Sdn. Bhd., which was incorporated on 2 May 2025 through the Group’s wholly-owned Mansfield Manufacturing Company Limited.

The advanced manufacturing facility features high-tonnage stamping machines, including 400-ton presses, secondary processing equipment such as tapping, welding and surface finishing, including powder coating, automated production lines, and quality assurance systems with inspection tools. Automated production lines have also been installed to enhance productivity and operational efficiency.

While strategically positioned to serve InnoTek’s existing key customers in precision engineering sector, the Melaka facility also offers flexibility to support new customers across Southeast Asia, in line with the Group’s strategy to expand into higher-value industries.

The total capital investment for the facility amounts to approximately S\$5 million, with operations expected to commence this year, progressively ramping up in line with customer qualification processes.

It adds to the Group's Southeast Asian footprint, as more customers shift their manufacturing out of China to mitigate supply chain disruptions and geopolitical risks. Besides its six existing facilities in China, the Group has one manufacturing facility in Vietnam and one facility in Thailand.

Mr Neal Chandaria, Chairman of InnoTek, said: "I would like to thank the InnoTek management team, for their hard work in establishing this facility. Our expanded geographical footprint will increase our production capacity and strengthen our business foundation to better serve customers and add long-term value to our shareholders."

Mr Lou Yiliang, CEO of InnoTek said: "The Melaka facility is a key step in our regional expansion. As we continue to grow our business, having a strong and flexible manufacturing presence across Southeast Asia is critical. The facility enhances our ability to serve customers with the quality, cost, delivery and service standards they expect."
